Course Offerings

Miami Sunset Senior High School offers a magnitude of classes geared towards the pursuit of Higher education and the advancement in technology. We offer a Medical Magnet program, Engineering Magnet program, Communications: Digital Media/Multimedia Design and Cybersecurity Magnet Program, as well as academies for students to participate in. During a student's ninth grade year, they begin with an entry level academy course which also covers transitional course content, helping a student transition into the high school setting. Students who complete four courses within their academy graduate as an academy completer. Additionally, we now offer AP Capstone, an innovative diploma program that develops student's critical skills needed to succeed in college and life.

#### **Dual Enrollment:**

Dual Enrollment is a program that allows high school students currently attending accredited Miami-Dade County public or private high schools or Home School Program to simultaneously enroll in a college course. The credits that students earn are used toward both high school graduation and are acceptable toward a College degree or Technical Certificate.

Dual Enrollment is available through a partnership between Miami Sunset Senior High School and Miami Dade College (MDC). Transportation is provided to MDC during the school day. Textbooks are provided to the students who participate in the Dual Enrollment program. To be eligible for Dual Enrollment a student must:

- Have a minimum of a 3.0 unweighted GPA
- Passed the appropriate sections of PERT or appropriate SAT/ACT scores
- Obtain permission from Parent, Guidance Counselor and Principal

#### Anti-Discrimination Policy

#### Federal and State Laws

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida adheres to a policy of nondiscrimination in employment and educational programs/activities and strives affirmatively to provide equal opportunity for all as required by:

<u>Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964</u> - prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, or national origin.

The Equal Pay Act of 1963 as amended - prohibits gender discrimination in payment of wages to women and men performing substantially equal work in the same establishment.

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 - prohibits discrimination against the disabled.

<u>Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA)</u> - prohibits discrimination against individuals with disabilities in employment, public service, public accommodations and telecommunications.

<u>The Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 (FMLA)</u> - requires covered employers to provide up to 12 weeks of unpaid, job-protected leave to "eligible" employees for certain family and medical reasons.

<u>The Pregnancy Discrimination Act of 1978</u> prohibits discrimination in employment on the basis of pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions.

Florida Educational Equity Act (FEEA) - prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, gender, national origin, marital status, or handicap against a student or employee.

<u>Florida Civil Rights Act of 1992</u> - secures for all individuals within the state freedom from discrimination because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, handicap, or marital status.

Title II of the Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act of 2008 (GINA) - prohibits discrimination against employees or applicants because of genetic information.

Boy Scouts of America Equal Access Act of 2002 — no public school shall deny equal access to, or a fair opportunity for groups to meet on school premises or in school facilities before or after school hours, or discriminate against any group officially affiliated with Boy Scouts of America or any other youth or community group listed in Title 36 (as a patriotic society).

Veterans are provided re-employment rights in accordance with P.L. 93-508 (Federal Law) and Section 295.07 (Florida Statutes), which stipulate categorical preferences for employment.

#### In Addition:

School Board Policies 1362, 3362, 4362, and 5517 - Prohibit harassment and/or discrimination against students, employees, or applicants on the basis of sex, race, color, ethnic or national origin, religion, marital status, disability, genetic information, age, political beliefs, sexual orientation, gender, gender identification, social and family background, linguistic preference, pregnancy, and any other legally prohibited basis. Retaliation for engaging in a protected activity is also prohibited.
