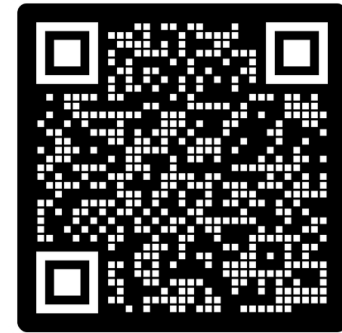

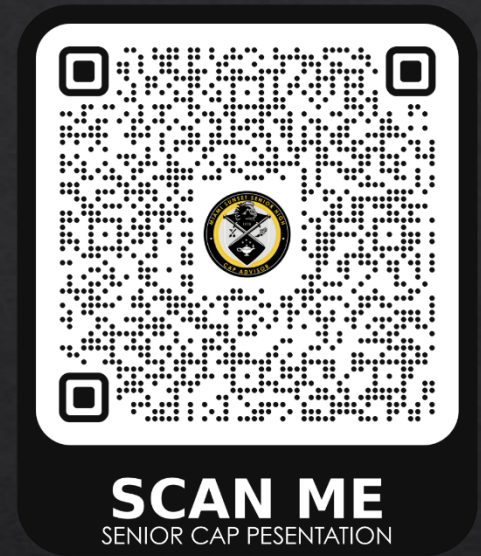

- **All Students MUST have an active SCOIR account** (We opened it together last week.)
- **Communication with Counselor/CAP Advisor**
- **All pertinent documents will be submitted to the schools via SCOIR**
- **All Parents are encouraged to have an active SCOIR account** (app.scoir.com)

# College Application Due Dates

<b>Early Action</b>	<b>The early bird, gets the worm. Non-binding</b>	<b>Oct 15 – Nov. 15</b>
<b>Early Decision</b>	<b>Binding – If accept, you must attend.</b>	<b>Nov 1 – Nov 15</b>
<b>Priority Deadlines</b>	<b>Better chances for scholarship, honors and housing</b>	<b>Nov - Jan</b>
<b>Regular Decision</b>		<b>Jan 1 – Feb 15</b>
<b>Rolling Admissions</b>	<b>Schools review applications, as they come in.</b>	<b>No deadlines</b>

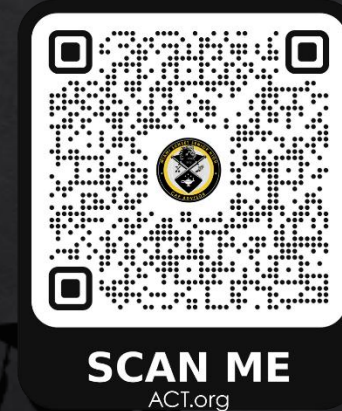

# FAFSA Information

## What is FAFSA?

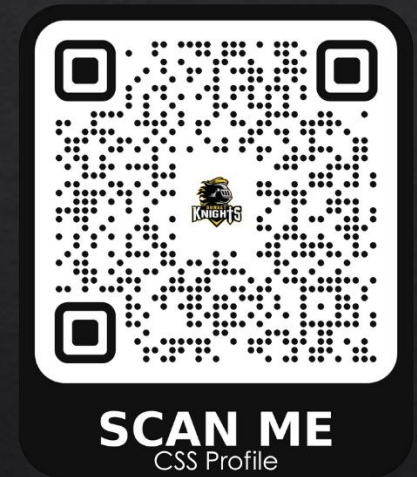
**FAFSA** stands for **Free Application for Federal Student Aid**.

It's a free form that students and parents fill out every year to see if they qualify for money to help pay for college.

That money can include:

- **Grants** (free money you don't pay back)
- **Scholarships**
- **Work-study jobs**
- **Low-interest student loans**

Requires 2023 and 2024 Income Tax Returns and both students and parents must have an **FSA ID** to complete the application.

You should create your FSA ID and saved prior to FAFSA Night.

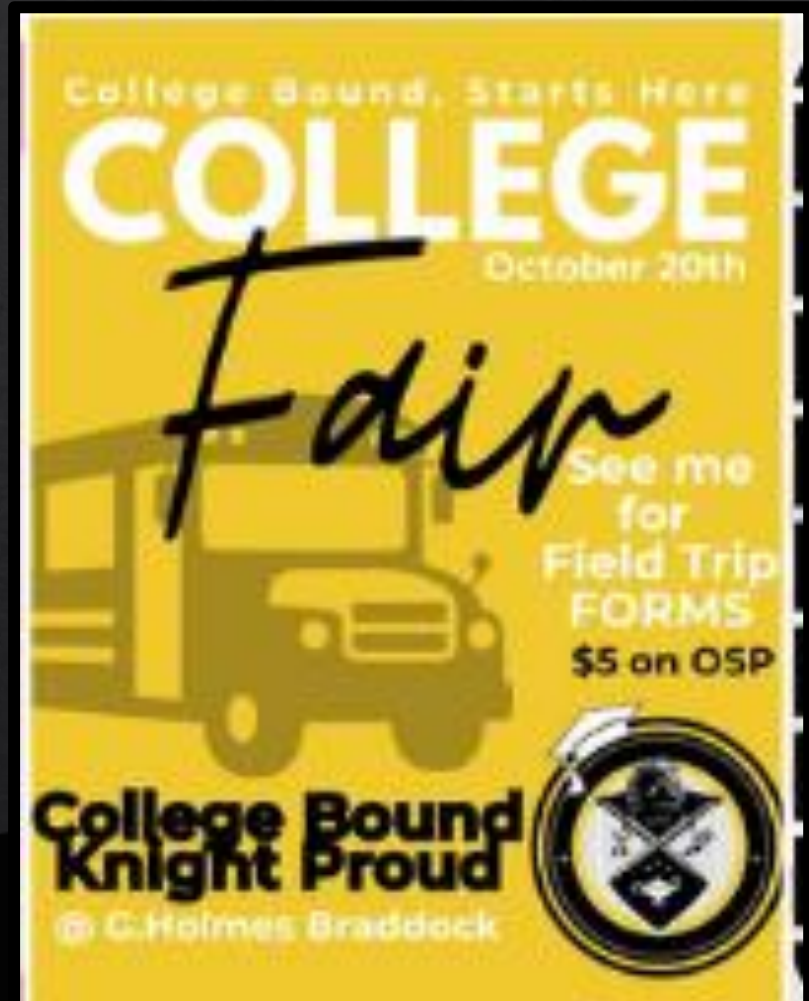
